SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant's parent or student must be an active member, in good standing of FRMCU for at least six months prior to application.
- Applicant must be a high school senior accepted to a college/university undergraduate program or a full time student enrolled in a college/university undergraduate program. Proof of acceptance required.
- The applicant must submit a completed application along with academic transcripts, and a one-page essay of their career goals.
- Employees and members of the Board of Directors and their immediate family members are not eligible to apply.

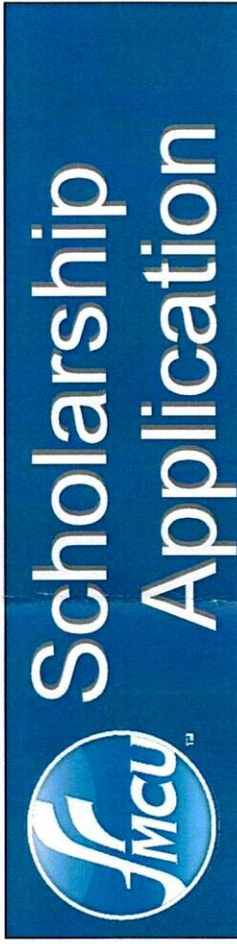

- The student/applicant must submit completed application, academic transcripts, and a one-page essay on their career goals.
- It is the applicant's responsibility to provide Fall River Municipal Credit Union with high school/college transcripts.
- All information provided will remain confidential.
- Employees and members of the Board of Directors and their immediate family members are not eligible to apply.
- Six scholarships will be awarded at the Annual Meeting.
