The personal statement must be **typed** and should contain no more than 300 words. <u>The personal statement</u> must include your education, career goals, and reasons for applying for this scholarship. The essay must be **typed** and should contain no more than 300 words. <u>The essay</u> must address: How your culture has impacted your life and/or your participation in your community. A resume may be included for work experience.

Interviews are required of each finalist. Your completed application with transcript, essay, personal statement, and two letters of recommendation must be received by April 12, 2024.
